

# 8 Point Star No Y Seams

## Background Fabric

## Star Points Fabric

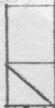
In 1,2,4, or 8 colours

Squares Cut 8	Large Rectangles Cut 8	Small Rectangles Cut 8
2	$3\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{3}{4}$	$2 \times 4\frac{3}{4}$
2½	$4 \times 5\frac{3}{4}$	$2\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{3}{4}$
3	$4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{3}{4}$	$3 \times 6\frac{3}{4}$
3½	$5 \times 7\frac{3}{4}$	$3\frac{1}{2} \times 7\frac{3}{4}$
4	$4 \times 8\frac{3}{4}$	$4 \times 8\frac{3}{4}$
4½	$6 \times 9\frac{3}{4}$	$4\frac{1}{2} \times 9\frac{3}{4}$
5	$6\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{3}{4}$	$5 \times 10\frac{3}{4}$

Draw a diagonal line on all the squares on wrong side of fabric.



Place 1 square on each of 4 small (star points) rectangles, right sides together, with diagonal line going high left to bottom right (obtuse).

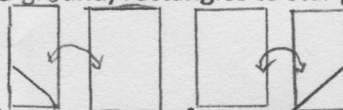


Then place 1 square on each of 4 rectangles, right sides together, matching the square with the base of the rectangle with diagonal line going bottom left to high right (acute)



Sew along the diagonal line on each of 8 rectangles, cut ¼ inch beyond sewn line make sure cut is on short side of the line. Press seams.

With right sides together sew large (background) rectangles to star points, with the sewing line on the side with the point at the bottom. Press seam.



With right sides together, place one obtuse on top of one acute with colours right sides together in 4 sets, sew along the colour side of each of the sets

Draw a diagonal line (same direction as diagonal line on star point) THIS IS DRAWING LINE ONLY NOT A CUTTING LINE.

Then draw a ¼ inch line on either side of the diagonal line. SEW ON BOTH of these lines.



Cut apart on original diagonal line. You now have a star set and a windmill set, Sew each quadrant together with other matching quadrant, then the two halves together to form a block. You now have the making of two different quilts or a quilt with stars and windmills
