

# Wonky, Tricks and Techniques Workshop

## You need:

Sewing machine with new needle and ¼ in foot

Thread, neutral

Rotary cutter (new blade if possible). Cutting mats will be provided.

Scissors, you may be cutting paper as well as fabric

12 x 6 ruler or larger

Small iron and pressing mat if you have one, extension cord IF you have one

Paper and pen/pencil to take notes if you wish

Fabric will be provided, if you wish to bring your own fabric, please do so, however remember the morning session will be emphasising techniques not the block.

The afternoon session (this is where you might want your own fabric and colour choices)

will result in finished blocks. We will make four blocks- for the first you will need 3- 10x10 coordinating fabrics, for the second, 4- 6x6 light and 4- 6x6 dark or contrasting colours, for the third 2 -10x10 contrasting squares and for the last some of your background with assorted scraps.

It is not necessary to prep ahead but some folks like to.
